HCLP To Oppose KISD Bond Issue by Jeff Daiell

The Katy ISD is proposing a \$261 million bond issue. It's currently set for a vote in May. The HCLP will be opposing this issue on three grounds:

- (1) Schools should be a function of the private sector.
- (2) It would be foolish to approve the bond issue before the Legislature's expected action on the school system is passed.
- (3) Even if the first two arguments are rejected, pay-as-you-go is better than bonded indebtedness.
